Mission

The Westchester Golf Association Caddie Scholarship Fund, a 501(c)(3) charitable and educational nonprofit corporation under the IRS Code, provides need based financial assistance to qualified caddies and others who work in service to golf, aiding the pursuit of higher education.

History

William P. Turnesa, an honorary member of Knollwood Country Club and Quaker Ridge Golf Club, and longtime friend, Udo Reinach, a member of Quaker Ridge Golf Club, founded the Reinach-Turnesa Scholarship Fund in 1956, now the Westchester Golf Association Caddie Scholarship Fund. Awards have been made to over 2,000 deserving young men and women who have received approximately \$9,000,000 in scholarship awards.

As we enter our 54th year of providing educational financial assistance to young men and women in service to golf, we realize how important our mission is, and how difficult the financing of higher education has become for the neediest students. As college costs continue to increase, and federal, state and university financial aid fails to keep pace, the burden on our scholars, the financing "gap", continues to widen, with student or parent loans often taken out to bridge that gap. Our awards provide meaningful assistance, and in some cases, are the difference between a student starting his/her college education or putting it off to a future date, if at all. The need grows.

This year, we awarded seventy-one new scholarships, and we will have 266 scholars attending school this fall. Our total commitment to those students is \$3.6 million.

In our latest fiscal year, the contribution from our principal fundraising activity, the club Bag Tag Program, exceeded \$1 million for the first time, and, for that, we give our thanks to all. Total contributions from all sources, including our major sponsor, *The Journal News*, also set a record and have more than doubled in the past ten years. In addition, the annual Pro-Am continued to provide a steady source of funds.

Despite our recent success, given the uncertainty of fundraising in the current economic environment, we have sought new sources of contributions. Our Inaugural Golf Marathon on August 24 at Trump National Golf Club in Briarcliff Manor, NY resulted in close to \$100,000 in pledges. We plan to make the marathon an annual event. The marathon revenues will be reflected in our fiscal year ending 6/30/2010.

On behalf of the Board of Directors, Officers and staff of the CSF and of our scholarship recipients, we thank you for your continuing support. The mission is challenging, but the rewards are great.

Ways to Help

Current Scholarship Recipients
