

Elmsford, NY – The Westchester Golf Association Tournament Committee announced Wednesday that they have changed the format of the WGA Husband & Wife/ Mixed Twosome Championships and the WGA Father & Son Championship. The tournaments will revert back to their previous set-up as Pinehurst style competitions. Pinehurst format is a team competition in which both team members hit tee shots on every hole, they then play their next shot with their partner's ball. After playing their second shots, the team selects one ball and plays an alternate-shot format from that point. Bob Thomas, Executive Director of the Westchester Golf Association, said he “hopes players will be happy with the change in format, as the Pinehurst format is one of the more popular formats for these events.” He also mentioned that registration for the WGA 2009 tournament season will open on March 1st, “we have a great line-up of clubs for this season including Fairview Country Club for the WGA Amateur Championship and Brooklawn Country Club for The Journal News WGA 87th Open Championship.” To view the full Westchester Golf Association tournament schedule visit www.westchestergolf.org.
